Chiropractors Board of Qld Chair joins national board



The Chiropractors Board of Queensland extended its congratulations to its Chair, Dr Mark McEwan, on his appointment as practitioner member from Queensland to the Chiropractic Board of Australia.

The Australian Health Workforce Ministerial Council announced the appointment of 108 inaugural members of ten national boards for the new National Registration and Accreditation Scheme for the Health Professions which commences on 1 July 2010.

Dr McEwan is one of 72 practitioner members to join a national Board and one of 39 members currently chairing a State Board.

He joined the Chiropractors Board of Queensland in 2002 and was appointed to Chair in 2006.

Dr McEwan is the principal chiropractor and business manager in a multidisciplinary practice, with 28 years of private clinical practice.
